

Ocean Grande Resort –Grenada, West Indies

Ocean Grande Resort development located at a the pristine tropical destination of Grenada island is an oceanfront luxury resort development featuring 200 hotel residences and villas, including vacation ownership, and the 18-court Grande Tennis Center. Accessibility: ***By Air:*** Grenada's main airport, Maurice Bishop International Airport (MBIA) which is managed by the Grenada Airport Authority has excellent connections with North America and Europe via direct flights and other Caribbean islands. MBIA is located just south of St. George's and close to the island's hotel and tourism belt. The airport is capable of handling large commercial jets for both day and night landings. A smaller airport is located in the sister isle of Carriacou and is utilized for inter-island services. ***By Sea:*** The Grenada Ports Authority (GPA) is responsible for both administration and operation of seaports located within Grenada, Carriacou and Petit Martinique. The chief port at St. George's is the main responsibility of the Grenada Ports Authority. The authority also has jurisdiction over Grenville, Prickly Bay and St. David's Harbour all located on mainland Grenada and the ports of Hillsborough and Tyrell Bay on Carriacou.

Why Choose Grenada? Tourism is Grenada's main economic force. Conventional beach and water-sports tourism is largely focused in the southwest region around St George, the airport and the coastal strip. Ecotourism is growing in significance. Most small ecofriendly guesthouses are located in the Saint David and Saint John parishes. The tourism industry is increasing dramatically with the construction of a large cruise ship pier and esplanade. Up to four cruise ships per day were visiting St. Georges in 2007–2008 during the cruise ship season. Grenada has many idyllic beaches around its coastline including the 3 km (1.9 mi) long Grand Anse Beach in St George which is considered to be one of the finest beaches in the world and often appears in countdowns of the world's top ten beaches.

Citizen Investor Program: The Citizenship by Investment Committee (CBIC) was established by the Honorable Prime Minister of Grenada and is the Government authority responsible for processing all applications for Citizenship by Investment by applicants and their family. Once citizenship of Grenada has been granted, you will have the all of the same rights as any Grenadian citizen. Grenadian passport allows visa-free travel to over 120 countries worldwide, including the UK, People's Republic of China and many countries of European Union.
